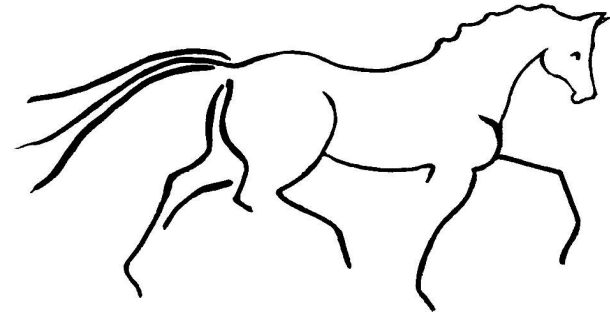

GENERAL RULES & INFORMATION

ENTRY FEES	\$20 per class. Entries by Thursday at midnight to avoid \$10 late fee, fax or email acceptable. Entries or changes must be made at least 15 minutes prior to start of class entered. Payment or open check required for issuance of number. Office fee of \$15 per entry. Horses brought for schooling only must register and pay grounds fee of \$40
COGGINS	NEGATIVE COGGINS test must be presented to the show secretary for all horses. Test must be less than 12 months old per Texas law.
STALL FEE	\$25 per day, including shavings or \$25 overnight. Shared paddock - \$25 per day per horse.
CONCESSIONS	Served on the premises. Come hungry, it's delicious!
HARD HATS & BOOTS	ASTM approved helmets and boots must be worn when mounted. Half chaps permitted if same color as paddock boots.
EQUIPMENT	Martingales are not allowed in flat classes.
DOGS	All dogs must be on a leash and please clean up after your dog.
SCHOOLING	Allowed Saturday after 2:00 p.m. and Sun. until 15 min. before start of show.

The Show Management reserves the right to change, cancel or combine any classes or do anything deemed necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries. The management shall decide all questions not covered in the USEF rules and regulations.

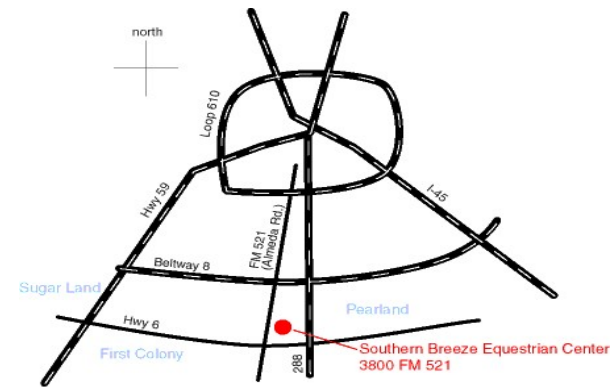

RECOGNIZED DIVISIONS

DIVISIONS

ALL EQUITATION CLASSES TO BE JUDGED ON HANDS, LEGS, SEAT, CONTROL OF MOUNT AND TURNOUT.

All equitation classes are open divisions.

Walk-Trot Equitation: No cross entries into any other divisions. Four classes; Walk/Trot Equitation; Equitation over ground poles; Figure Eight; Horsemanship. Horsemanship class may include sitting trot, 2-point, halt and simple questions regarding tack, gaits and parts, colors or markings of the horse.

X-Rail Equitation: No cross entries into any other divisions. Fences 18" maximum (small X's) with a simple jump course of twice around. Participants may trot or canter fences with leads between jumps not to be considered. Four classes - Walk/Trot Equitation, Walk/Trot/Canter Equitation and two equitation over fences classes.

Beginner / Novice Equitation: Fences 2' with simple courses to be cantered with leads to count. Four classes - Walk/Trot/Canter Equitation and three equitation over fences classes.

Open Equitation: Open to all. One flat class and three over fences classes. Fences 2'6" - 2'9". One class to include 2 USEF tests 1-18 with no switching of horses.

Jumpers

X Rail Jumper: No cross entry into open Jumper. 3 classes. 1st class is equitation, 2nd and 3rd are scored on faults within time allowed at the trot or canter.

Open Jumper: Open to all. Fences 2' to 3'6". Heights to be selected by the rider - 2', 2'6", 3' or 3'6". Spreads not wider than fence height plus 3". Classes - Time First Jump Off, Time First Round, Power & Speed

MISCELLANEOUS CLASSES

WALK ONLY EQUITATION - To be shown at a walk and judged on position. All entries may be led and may have side walkers. **This is a perfect class for young beginners and riders with special needs.**

WALK/TROT WITH ASSISTANCE - To be shown at a walk and trot in both directions. To be judged on position. All entries may be led and may have side walkers. **This is a perfect class for young beginners and riders with special needs.**

WARM-UP CLASSES - A warm-up class will be held for each arena with a separate warm-up for jumpers. Judge's card may be held open through several divisions.
